The British Association for Slavonic and East European Studies (BASEES) invites proposals for panels, roundtables, and papers for its 2026 annual conference.

BASEES 2026 is being held in-person from the 10-12 April at University of Birmingham, United Kingdom. The conference will also welcome remote attendees. The 2024 conference in Cambridge welcomed 700 delegates from over 45 countries around the world.

Tips on submitting your abstract

Stage 1 – Abstract Title

Provide the title of your abstract. Indicate whether your submission is part of a panel and select the conference stream that best aligns with your work.

- Note: If you are submitting an individual paper, please ensure you do not attach yourself to a panel. Please select - General Submission - No Panel

Stage 2 – Abstract

Enter your abstract (maximum 3,000 characters). We strongly recommend drafting your abstract in a separate document and then copying it into the submission form.

- Note: Formatting (e.g., bold, italics, HTML markups) counts toward the character limit. Aim to keep the text under 3,000 characters in plain text.
- Authors are responsible for proofreading and ensuring their abstracts are free from grammatical or typographical errors.

Stage 3 – Author Details Add the details of all contributing authors.

Stage 4 – Submission Review your information carefully before submitting your abstract.

The deadline for paper and panel/roundtable proposals is Friday, 24 October 2025

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Tips on submitting a roundtable

Stage 1 – Login/ Register

Please create an account on our registration software, Eventflo, by clicking on 'Submit an Abstract'. Once created, you will be guided to a page to choose either an Oral or Roundtable

Stage 2 – Add a Roundtable Title (up to 230 characters)

Once you have added a name, please select which Stream the roundtable will most suit. You will also need to add a chair on this page and a Panel Abstract or Description.

Stage 3 – Abstract

Enter your abstract (maximum 3,000 characters). We strongly recommend drafting your abstract in a separate document and then copying it into the submission form.

- Note: Formatting (e.g., bold, italics, HTML markups) counts toward the character limit. Aim to keep the text under 3,000 characters in plain text.
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Stage 4 – Add Participants

This is where you can add your roundtable participants.

Note: Ensure the email address you put down for your participants is the same as the one they will register with. This will link them to your roundtable and show up in their schedule.

Stage 1 – Login/ Register

Please create an account on our registration software, Eventflo, by clicking on 'Submit an Abstract'. Once created, you will be guided to a page that asks to 'Set up a New Panel'. Please click on the button.

Stage 2 – Add a Panel Name

Once you have added a name, please select which Track Subject Area the panel will most suit. You will also need to add a chair on this page and a Panel Abstract or Description.

Stage 3 – Invite your fellow panellists.

Send an email to your fellow panellists with the following details:
